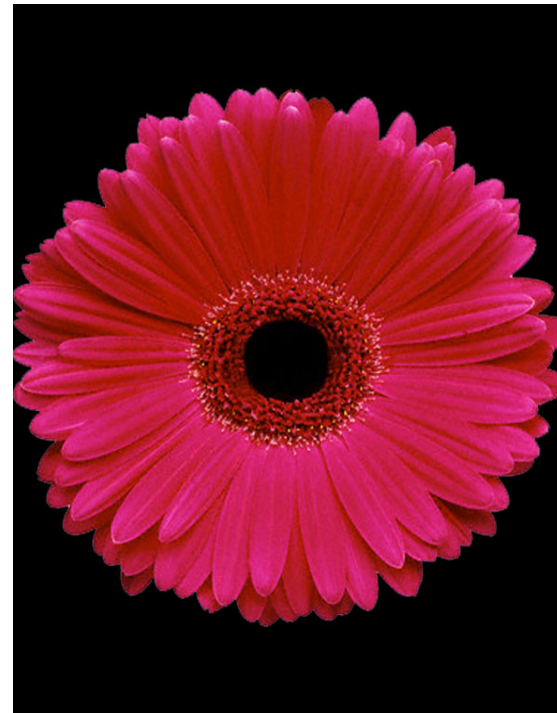

*Wow, the thunder and lighting are powerful. How do they display the power and wonder of God?*

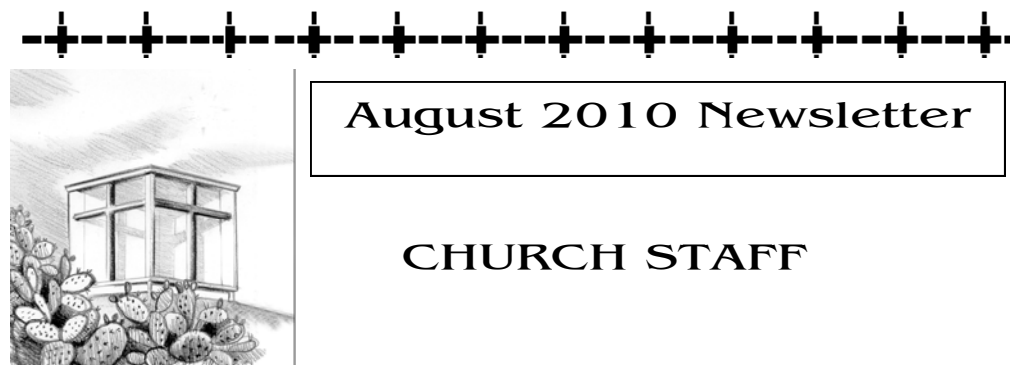

# Helpful Information About CPC

## SAFEWAY

*Every year we must do the annual renewal of our Safeway cards for credit to continue to go to CPC youth. If you were previously listed with us we have renewed for you. If you have recently obtained a Safeway card we need to add your card number to our account. Either fill out the form on the counter in the office or call the church office.*

## ALBERTSONS

***The Community Partners cards are in!** You can pick one up in the church office. Then, every time you shop at Albertsons have the clerk swipe the card. CPC gets 1% of the first \$50,000 of purchases and \$5 on everything over that per quarter.*

## Health Sunday

*The parish nurses are available on Blood Pressure Sundays, usually the fourth Sunday of the month, to collect expired prescription and over-the-counter medications. These medications will be donated to World Care. This is a great opportunity to clean out the medicine chest and help others who may not be able to afford medications. World Care sends the medications to developing countries. This is also a very safe way to dispose of medications that are no longer needed.*

*Medications should never be put down the drain, because sanitary systems are unable to filter the medications out of the water. Empty medication bottles may be placed in the blue Parish Nurse Bin near the window on the west side of the Fellowship Hall.*

## A Word From Your Mission Team....

*In late June, we received a phone call from a woman living in Michigan, asking for help for her daughter, a young woman living here in Tucson. The young lady is a mother of three small children and was in an abusive situation. She had moved in with friends after losing her apartment, while the children remained with their father. When he left for the day, she stayed with the children. The out of state mother was able to send four plane tickets to her daughter so that she and the children could leave Tucson. The big problem was an unpaid storage bill and the fact that the family's important documents were in the storage unit. The CPC Mission Team was able to step up and pay the storage bill. Through the generous contributions of several people in the congregation we were also able to ship a lot of the children's clothing and toys to their new home. About now, you are wondering how the mother from out of state got in touch with us, aren't you? No, they did not call the church. Actually, the young woman in Tucson went to our community partners, Interfaith Community Services last Christmas to ask for help for her family. They were chosen by a company here in town, through Pam Raines, to receive "Gifts of Love" assistance for the holidays just like four families we elected to help this past December. The Grandmother had Pam's phone number and called her and the Mission Team went to work. Your mission dollars at work!! Thank you to CPC!!!*

*The Mission Team wants to send a huge THANK YOU to Dawn Gerhart, owner of the UPS Store at 9121 E Tanque Verde Ste 105. When Pam called her for some suggestions on the best way to pack and ship the many boxes, she was so generous in her offering of a donation of the boxes and packing materials. She even packed all of the items for us and gave us a discount on the shipping fees. What an angel !!!! We couldn't have done without her.*

### **Mexico Home Building Mission Cancelled**

*Due to recent drug-related activity in and around Rocky Point, Mexico, our mission trip scheduled for Nov. has been cancelled. While the violence is directed at local law enforcement, we feel we cannot recruit participants when there is any possibility of danger.*

*There are over 250 Americans who are permanent residents in Rocky Point, and many others continue to travel there without incident. However, tourism will be affected, with local merchants and employees depend on for their livelihood - a sad time for a quiet Mexican seaside town. Should the situation change, it will be announced in the KIVA.*

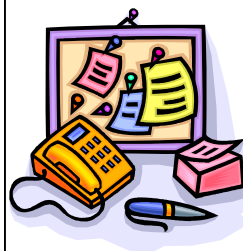
### Desert Dolphins,

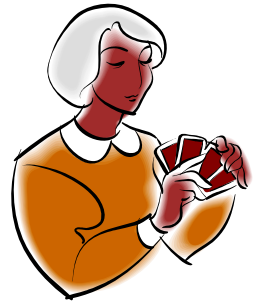

One Sunday morning, a mother went in to wake her son and tell him it was time to get ready for church, to which he replied, "I'm not going."

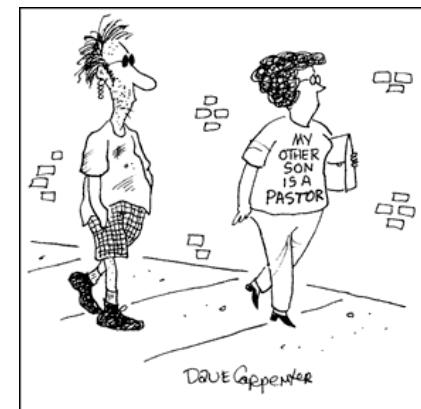
"Why not?" she asked.
